EXPLANATION OF STALLION REQUIREMENTS

All Moorland breeds/crossbreeds of stallion are eligible for approval: there is no restriction as to colour but height should not exceed 12.2hh. Each stallion <u>MUST</u> be of sound conformation and suitably hardy, as stated below.

a) HEALTH & FITNESS

The Stallion must be in good condition, have sound teeth, and no signs of illness, disease or injury.

b) HARDINESS

The stallion must be of a suitable type to out-winter on the Dartmoor commons, without significant loss of condition, and without winter feeding, except in extreme weather conditions. In particular the stallion must have sufficient bone.

c) **CONFORMATION**

The stallion must meet basic sound conformation requirements, including good feet.

d) SOUNDNESS IN LIMB AND CORRECT ACTION

The stallion must have no significant swellings or bony enlargements on the limbs. There must be no sign of lameness. The stallion's action must be straight with no significant peculiarities.

e) ENTIRE CHARACTERISTICS

The stallion must look like a stallion, i.e. show distinctive male characteristics in behaviour and physique. It must also be fully developed.
